- The original birth certificate and current shot records must be presented at the time of enrollment.**

1. If you have a student starting Kindergarten (K4 or K5) *or* moving in from another state, the child must have a physical exam. The Commonwealth of Virginia school entrance health form (MCH 213G, revised 2014) is available online for your physician to complete. Your child **may not** begin school without this completed school physical on file in the school office.
2. Immunization booster requirements:
 - ◆ All 7th grade students are required to receive the **Tdap booster** within one week of his/her 11th birthday.
 - ◆ As of July 2021, a minimum of 2 doses of **MenACWY** (meningococcal conjugate vaccine) are also required:
The first dose should be administered prior to entering 7th grade.
The final dose should be administered prior to entering 12th grade.
(HPV administered at the parent's sole discretion.)Documentation of the boosters must be provided to the school office.
3. The Emergency Contact form list is very important. We will contact parents **first**; we will then attempt to contact the numbers in order of priority you listed. Prior to adding someone to the list, please make them aware that they will have such authority.
4. **Book fees, Enrichment, and Science Lab fees are due by August 20.**
Tuition payments are billed on the 1st of the month, and are due by the 20th of each month (late fee on the 21st).
All payments for tuition and fees are *non-refundable*.
5. Piano lessons are available upon request. Lessons are offered on a first come, first served basis. If you are interested, please contact the school office for information. The total cost is \$1,000* per year, payable in 10 payments.
**Organ, string, brass, and woodwind lessons are also available, with costs higher.*
6. Students transferring to Heritage are required to undergo placement testing, unless prior arrangements have been made with the Principal. There is a \$75.00 fee for placement testing (no checks accepted).
7. **Sports:**
 - All students planning to try out for any sport must have a **yearly Sports physical** (VHSL form) done by **August 10**.
 - Varsity Soccer and Volleyball tryouts (grades 9—12) will be held on **August 11-12** from 2:30—5:00 p.m.
Junior Varsity tryouts (grades 7—10) will be held after school on Wednesday, **August 25** from 3:15—4:30 p.m.
 - An Athletic fee is due upon selection to a Varsity or Junior Varsity team. This once-yearly fee covers all sports played:
Varsity fee \$100.00; Junior Varsity fee \$75.00.
8. Parent/Teacher meetings:
Should you desire to meet with your child's teacher before school begins, please call the office to schedule an appointment. Appointments will be available on **Thursday, August 18**, from 10:00 a.m. — 7:00 p.m.
9. Those students desiring to participate in the Scripture Memory Contest should submit the form by Friday, **August 26**.
10. The Patriot Planner is designed to help both you and your child with school correspondence. The first copy is included in your book fee. Additional copies cost \$10.00 each. The Parent/Student Handbook is available online (thru the Patriot Portal).
11. We ask that your child be here *no later than 8:20 a.m.* so that school may start promptly at 8:25 a.m. Failure to be on time more than 5 times during the year will remove your child's eligibility for perfect attendance. Also, please note other rules in the handbook concerning excessive tardiness.
12. ALL STUDENTS should enter through the breezeway between the auditorium and educational building.
